In June 2008 Michael Forbes - a dedicated father, IT professional, competitive cyclist and triathlete – was involved in a serious accident while training on Beach Road. Mike was hit by a vehicle and forced in to a parked car. Mike's neck was broken, resulting in irreversible damage to his cervical spine, leaving him a quadriplegic. Mike's injuries mean that he requires ongoing 7-day a week care and intensive rehabilitation therapies.

Mike's determination and progress since his accident have been truly inspirational. At this point he has progressed a long way from his initial prognosis. He is determined to maximise his functional recovery to allow him to perform as many everyday tasks as possible and increase his independence.

Mike's family, friends and the community in general are pulling together to support and raise funds for Mike and his family and 'A Night with Mike' is a great opportunity to support Mike and have a great evening out.
